Application deadline: September 1, 2017. We will accept applications later – until Sept. 4 - but there is no guarantee that you will be listed in the program.

Preparation of work:

All work must be ready for display. Art work to be hung **must have proper wiring and support**. No sawtooth hangers.

Artist's name, contact information, title, medium and price must be clearly noted and permanently attached to the rear or bottom of the artwork.

An exhibition title card will be created when work is delivered.

Valley Arts reserves the right to not display items properly prepared.

Special display needs:

Valley Arts has a limited number of lightweight display stands available (approximately 12" in diameter) on a first come basis.

It is highly suggested that you provide your own display devices. You can be creative with your display; however, Valley Arts reserves the right of final decision on the appropriateness of the display. If in doubt, check with Valley Arts before September 1.

Jewelry and small items should be displayed in the artist's own case(s). Valley Arts does not own display cases. Tables will be provided.
